Gypsy Scarf

Made in America Yarns ×

Materials: 1 Skein Florafil Crista Galli Super Soft Cotton Yarn 2 markers

Needles: One size 11 24" circular needle

Cast on 151 sts.

Row 1: K6, place marker, K5, *P5, K5, repeat from * to last 10 sts, P4, place marker, K6. Row 2: K6, slip marker, K4, P5, *K5, P5, repeat from * to last 6 sts, slip marker and K6.

Repeat rows 1 and 2 to 3-1/2".

Bind off row (right side row): K6 and place these sts on a holder.

You will be dropping the 5th st. in each group of K5 or P5 as follows: *Bind off 3 sts. Drop first stitch on left needle and let it run to the bottom, including the cast on. Elongate the stitch on the right needle to "bridge the gap" made by the dropped stitch. Knit the next stitch on the left needle (do not tighten yarn across the gap). Bind off the elongated stitch on the right needle*.

Repeat from * to * to end of the row to last 6 sts.

Remove the last 6 sts from needle and gently unravel two rows at a time. Tie each loop into an overhand knot as close as possible to knit edge.Continue unraveling. Repeat for the 6 sts on the holder. Keep the loops for fringe or cut open.
