Indian Paintbrush Sweater

Materials: 6(7, 8) Skeins Florafil Indian Paintbrush Super Soft Cotton Yarn

Needles: One Size 10 24" circular needle One Size 10 16" circular needle (for sleeves)

Size: Small (Medium, Large)

Note: To increase knit front and back of

stitch

Cast on 72 (80,88) sts, being careful to not twist the yarn join.

Row 1: K11(12,13)(Front), place odd marker, K14(16,18)(Sleeve), place marker, K22(24,26) (Back), place marker, K14(16,18) (Sleeve), place marker, K11(12,13)(Front).

Row 2: Purl All, then purl to odd marker, slip marker. All rows will now begin at odd marker.

Row 3 Inc Row: K1, M1, Knit to one stitch before next marker, *M1, K1, slip marker, K1, M1, knit to one stitch before next marker* repeat * to * across row.

Row 4: Purl All.

Repeat rows 3 & 4 until 60 (70,80)sts in back section.

Divide for Sleeves and Join Body:

Starting at odd marker, slip marker, place sleeve sts on holding thread, remove marker, knit back sts, slip marker, place sleeve sts on holding thread, remove marker, knit front stitches.

Purl next round





Body:

Knit row increasing 6 sts evenly spaced across row and slipping markers.
Repeat increase row every 8th row 4(5,6) times total. Purl next row. Continue to alternate Knit rows and purl rows until desired length.

Bind off loosely. Weave in ends.
