Self-Fringing Wildflower Made in Umerica Yarns Shawl



Materials: 5 Skeins Florafil Super Soft Cotton Yarn (1 ea. Aster, Blue Hyacinth, Green Chrusanthemum, Helenium Mardi Gras. Red Hibiscus) 2 markers, 1 stitch holder

Needles: One Size 11 circular needle 24" lona

Size: Large: 20" x 92" Medium: 20" x 75" Small: 20" x 68" (Not including fringe)

Shawl

Cast on 131 sts for small, 151 for med, 161 sts for large shawl.

Row 1: K6, place marker, K5, *P5, K5, repeat from * to last 10 sts, P4, place marker, K6. Row 2: K6, slip marker, K4, P5, *K5, P5, repeat from * to last 6 sts, K6. Repeat rows 1 and 2 for 4-1/2" for each color.

Self-Fringing Bind Off

Bind off (right side row): Knit first 6 sts and place on holder. *Bind off 3 sts, drop first stitch on left hand needle and unravel to cast on edge (the 5th stitch in each group of K5 or P5 will be the stitch that's dropped). Lengthen the stitch on the right needle to create a bar to bridge the gap made by the dropped stitch, knit the next stitch loosely and bind off the elongated stitch.*

Repeat from * to * across shawl to last 6 sts. Take 6 sts off needle and carefully unravel two rows at a time. Knot each fringe close to the knit edge.

Repeat at opposite end with the 6 sts on holder.
