

American Wildflowers Collection

Neapolitan Wrap

MATERIALS

Florafil Super Soft Cotton Yarn:

3 skeins Color A: Pink Phlox

5 skeins Color B: Brown Galingale

3 skeins Color C: Chocolate Lily

One 24" #10 circular needle

One 16" #10 circular needle

One marker

Gauge: 3-1/2 sts per inch in stockinette.

14 rows = 3" in stockinette.

Finished Size: 56 1/2" x 38 1/2"

HILLS AND HOLES PATTERN STITCH:

Row 1: Knit (right side)

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: P2, * SL1P, P1 * repeat * to * ending P1

Row 4: K2, * SL1, K1 * repeat * to * ending K1 (you should be

slipping the purls and knitting the slips from the previous row)

Row 5: Knit

Row 6: Purl

Row 7: K2, * yo, k2tog * repeat * to *

Row 8: Purl

Row 9-14: repeat rows 1-6

Stockinette Stitch: Knit the right side, Purl the wrong side

Wrap:

Cast on 134 sts in Color A

Front Right Side:

Row 1: *K2, P2* repeat * to * across row ending K2

Row 2: *P2, K2* repeat * to * across row ending P2

Repeat rows 1&2 for 3-1/2" (16 rows in K2/P2 ribbing)

Change to Color B, Knit in Stockinette stitch for 3" (14 rows)

Change to Color C, Knit the Hills and Holes Pattern Stitch one time.

Change to Color B, Knit 3" in Stockinette Stitch (14 rows)

Change to Color A, Knit the Hills and Holes Pattern Stitch one time.

Change to Color B, Knit 3" in Stockinette Stitch (14 rows)

1st Armhole:

Note—the armhole is placed in the middle of a Hills and Holes pattern stitch

Change to Color C, Knit rows 1-4 of the Hills and Holes pattern stitch.

Row 5: K31 sts and move to a 16" circular needle.

Bind off the next 26 sts, K77 sts. (You now have a top and bottom section to be knit separately and then rejoined)





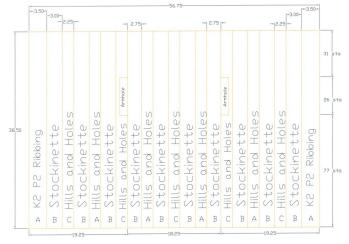








This pattern was gauged for use with Florafil Super Soft Cotton Yarns. We cannot guarantee similar results with use of other yarns.



Wrap Layout

Bottom and Top sections:

Row 6:Purl row

Row 7: K2, * yo, K2tog* repeat * to * to last stitch, K1.

Row 8: Purl

Row 9: Knit

Row 10: Purl

Row 11: P2 * SL1P, P1 * repeat * to * to last stitch, P1.

Row 12: K1, * SL1, K1 * repeat * to * across row

Row 13: Knit

Join Bottom and Top:

Row 14: Purl bottom 77 sts, cast on 26 sts, join and Purl top 31 sts. (all sts should now be back on the 24" circular)

Back:

Change to Color B, Knit 2-3/4" in Stockinette Stitch (12 rows)

Change to Color A, Knit the Hills and Holes Pattern Stitch one time.

Change to Color B, Knit 3" in Stockinette Stitch (14 rows)

Change to Color C, Knit the Hills and Holes Pattern Stitch one time.

Change to Color B, Knit 3" in Stockinette Stitch (14 rows)

Change to Color A, Knit the Hills and Holes Pattern Stitch one time.

Change to Color B, Knit 2-3/4" in Stockinette Stitch (12 rows)

2nd Armhole:

Change to Color C

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Purl 77 sts, Bind off 26 sts, Purl 31 sts and transfer to a 16" circular

Top and Bottom sections:

Row 3: P2, * SL1P, P1 * repeat * to * to last stitch, P1

Row 4: K1, * SL1, K1 * repeat * to * across row.

Row 5: Knit

Row 6: Purl

Row 7: K2, * yo, K2tog * repeat * to * to last stitch, K1

Row 8: Purl

Row 9: Knit

Join Bottom and Top Sections:

Row 10: Purl bottom 77 sts, cast on 26 sts, join and Purl top 31 sts

(all sts should now be back on the 24" circular)

Row 11: P2, * SL1P, P1 * repeat * to * ending P1

Row 12: K2, * SL1, K1 * repeat * to * ending K1

Row 13: Knit

Row 14: Purl

Left Front Side:

Change to Color B, Knit 3" in Stockinette Stitch (14 rows)

Change to Color A, Knit the Hills and Holes Pattern Stitch one time.

Change to Color B, Knit 3" in Stockinette Stitch (14 rows)

Change to Color C, Knit the Hills and Holes Pattern Stitch one time.

Change to Color B, Knit 3" in Stockinette Stitch (14 rows)

Change to Color A, Row 1: *K2, P2* repeat * to * across row ending K2

Row 2: *P2, K2* repeat * to * across row ending P2

Repeat rows 1&2 for 3-1/2" (16 rows in K2/P2 ribbing), Bind off loosely. Weave in ends.

Sleeves:

Using a 16" circular needle pickup 64 sts around the arm hole.

Place marker, join and knit 10 rounds.

Rnd 11: *P1, SL1P* repeat * to * across round.

Rnd 12: *SL1P, P1* repeat * to * across round.

Rnd 13 and 14: Knit

Rnd 15: * yo, k2tog* repeat * to * across round

Rnd 16 and 17: knit

(If longer sleeves are desired continue knitting to desired length)

Rnd 18 -21: * K2, P2 * repeat * to * across round

Bind off loosely, weave in ends.

multi-colored cotton hand-knitting yarn with the softness of roving and the strength of conventional ring-spun cotton. We suggest that for the best results you treat this as you would a hand painted yarn and alternate the skeins every few rows when using more than one skein of yarn in your project. To assure an overall blended effect, knit with two hanks, working 2-4 rows from each.

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
