a cozy, cabled hat by Katie Vlasov

Made in America Yarns
X

Materials: 1 Skein of American Lamb

Gauge: 4.5 stitches per inch

Needles: US Size 10 dpns or circ

Size: Adult

Note: Hat is worked from top down. Stitch count is shown in parenthesis at the end of each round.



Cast on

Cast on 4 stitches and join to work in the round.

Crown Increases

Round 1. KFB in every stitch (8)
Round 2. KFB in every stitch (16)
Round 3. (KFB, K1) repeat around (24)
Round 4. (KFB, K3) repeat around (30) *if desired, place marker after every repeat
Round 5. Knit all stitches
Round 6. (KFB, K4) repeat around (36)
Round 7. (KFB, K5) repeat around (42)
Round 8. Knit all stitches
Round 9. (KFB, K6) repeat around (48)
Round 10. (KFB, K7) repeat around (54)
Round 11. Knit all stitches
Round 12. (KFB, K8) repeat around (60)
Round 13. (KFB, K9) repeat around (66)
Round 14. (K1, P1, K9) repeat around
Round 15. (KFB, P1, K9) repeat around (72)
Round 16. (K1, P2, K9) repeat around
Round 17. (K1, P2, K7, KFB, P) repeat around (78)

Body

Round 1. (K1, P2, K8, P2) repeat around
Rounds 2-6. Repeat round 1.

Round 7. (K1, P2, slip 4 stitches to cable needle and hold in front, K4, K4 from cable needle, P2) repeat around
Rounds 8-15. Repeat round 1.
Round 16. Repeat round 7.
Rounds 17-24. Repeat round 1.
Round 25. Repeat round 7.
Rounds 26-29. Repeat round 1.
Round 30. Work K1, P1 ribbing for 12 stitches. Place marker. P1, K1, P2, K8, P2, K1, P2. Place marker. Work K1, P1 ribbing for 22 stitches. Place marker. P1, K1, P2, K8, P2, K1, P2. Place marker. Work K1, P1 ribbing for last 10 stitches.
Round 31. K1, P1 ribbing until marker. P1, K1, P2, K8, P2, K1, P2. K1, P1 ribbing until next marker. P1, K1, P2, K8, P2, K1, P2. K1, P1 ribbing until end of round.
Rounds 32-33. Repeat round 31.
Round 34. K1, P1 ribbing until marker. P1, K1, P2, slip 4 stitches to cable needle and hold in front, K4, K4 from cable needle, P2, K1, P2. K1, P1 ribbing until next marker.... (cont..)

... P1, K1, P2, slip 4 stitches to cable needle and hold in front, K4, K4 from cable needle, P2, K1, P2. K1, P1 ribbing until end of round. Rounds 35-37. Repeat round 31.

Earflaps

On next round remove markers as you work. Bind off 9 stitches in ribbing. Work even 21 stitches (K1, P2, K1, P2, K8, P2, K1, P2, K2). Place these 22 live stitches on a stitch holder (or leave on cable if magic looping). Bind off 17 stitches in ribbing. Work even 21 stitches (K1, P2, K1, P2, K8, P2, K1, P2, K2). Place these live stitches on a stitch holder (or leave on cable if magic looping). Bind off remaining 8 stitches in ribbing. Pull yarn through last stitch and break yarn.



Earflaps are now worked flat. With right side facing, rejoin yarn to one set of live stitches.

Row 1(RS). Slip 1, K1, P2, K1, P2, K8, P2, K1, P2, K2.
 Row 2(WS). Slip 1, P1, K2, P1, K2, P8, K2, P1, K2, P2.
 Row 3 (RS). Repeat row 1.
 Row 4 (WS). Repeat row 2.
 Row 5 (RS). Slip 1, K1, P2, K1, P2, slip 4 stitches to cable needle and hold in front, K4, K4 from cable needle, P2, K1, P2, K2.
 Row 6(WS). Slip 1, P1, ssk, P1, K2, P8, K2, P1, k2tog, P2 (20)
 Row 7(RS). Slip 1, K1, P1, K1, P2, K8, P2, K1, P1, K2
 Row 8(WS). Slip 1, P1, K1, P1, ssk, P8, k2tog, P1, K1, P2 (18)
 Row 9(RS). Slip 1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K8, P1, K1, P1, K2
 Row 10(WS). Slip 1, P1, pssso, K1, P1, K1, P8, K1, P1, K1, p2tog (16)

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Row 11(RS). Slip 1, P1, K1, P1, K8, P1, K1, P1, K1
 Row 12(WS). Slip 1, K1, P1, K1, Slip 1, P1, pssso, P4, p2tog, K1, P1, K1, P1 (14)
 Row 13(RS). Slip 1, P1, K1, P1, K6, P1, K1, P1, K1
 Row 14(WS). Slip 1, K1, P1, K1, slip 3 stitches to cable needle and hold in front, P3, P3 from cable needle, K1, P1, K1, P1
 Row 15(RS). Ssk, K1, P1, K6 P1, K1, k2tog (12)
 Row 16(WS). Slip 1, P1, K1, P6, K1, P2
 Row 17(RS). Ssk, P1, K6, P1, k2tog (10)
 Row 18(WS). Slip 1, K1 P6, K1, P1
 Row 19(RS). Slip 1, P1, ssk, K2, k2tog, P1, K1 (8)
 Row 20(WS). Slip 1, K1, P4, K1, P1
 Row 21 (RS). Slip 1, P1, ssk, k2tog, P1, K1 (6)
 Row 22(WS). Slip 1, K1, P2, K1, P1
 Row 23(RS). Ssk, K2, k2tog (4)

Work 4 stitch i-cord for six inches, bind off. For the tassel or pom-poms, leave two inch tail after pulling yarn through last stitch. Tassel only: Cut three six inch lengths of yarn. Fold these in half and use a crochet hook to pull the loops through the end of the i-cord. Thread ends of yarn through the loops and pull tightly.

Repeat for second earflap.

Finishing

Make a large pompom to attach to the top of the hat. Make 2 pompoms for bottom of earflaps if desired, in place of tassels. *I used the bottom of a coffee cup to make cardboard templates for my pompom.*
 Weave in ends.
