

# Converge Shawl

designed by Beck Gusler

Made in America Yarns

Materials: 2 Skeins of American Lamb, 1 in Main Color (MC) and 1 in Contrasting Color (CC).  
3 Stitch Markers

Gauge: 4.5 stitches per inch

Needles: US Size 10 dpns or circ

Size: Adult

*Note: Shawl is worked from top center outwards.*

## Set up

Cast on 3 stitches using MC and turn

Row 1 MC: k1fb, k1, k1fb (5 sts)

Row 2 MC: purl

Row 3 MC: k1, pm, yo, k1, yo, pm, k1, pm, yo, k1, yo, k1 (9 sts)

Row 4 MC: purl

Row 5 CC: k1, sm, yo, k3, yo, sm, k1, sm, yo, k3, yo, sm, k1 (13 sts)

Row 6 CC: purl.

## Shawl Body Repeat

You will now be working changing colors every 2 rows on the right-side edge as established.

Row 1: k1, sm, yo, knit to marker, yo, sm, k1, sm, yo, knit to marker, yo, sm, k1

Row 2: purl

Repeat these 2 rows until you have 16 stripes of your CC. Work rows 1, 2, and 1 once more in MC. Knit your next wrong side row.

## Edging

Row 1: \*k4, p2\* repeat to end

*Tip: You should end with p2 -if not, don't sweat it! Work extra stitches in pattern (Knit the knits, purl the purls)*

Row 2: \*k2, p4\* repeat to end

Repeat these 2 rows, 2 more times. You should have worked a total of 6 rows, ending with a wrong side row.

## Finishing

Bind off loosely in pattern. Weave in ends and block.
