## Here \& There designed by Jenny Bruce

## Materials:

1 skein of Wayfarer

Needles: US size $6(4 \mathrm{~mm}) 24$ inch or longer length circular needle.

Finished Size: 55inches $\times 25.5$ inches

Gauge: 18stitches/30 rows/4inches in stockinette stitch, blocked.
Gauge is not crucial but a difference in gauge will result in different size shawl and will change the amount of Yarn needed to complete the project. This is a one-skein project so please check your gauge.

## Important! About the Chart:

The chart represents one half of the triangle of the shawl. Read the charted rows from right to left, after the center stich the second triangle is a mirror image of the first triangle.
All odd rows are knit; all even rows are purled except where highlighted in orange $\mathcal{E}$ also noted on instructions.

## Instructions:

Garter Tab Cast On:
Cast on 3 stitches and knit 6 rows. Turn work 90 degrees clockwise, pick up and knit 3 stitches on the garter stitch ridges on the edge of the work. You will now have 6 stitches.
Pick up and knit 3 stitches on the cast on edge. You will now have nine stitches.
Shawl Body:
Begin working from the chart - place markers as for written row below around your 3 edge ats and center st.

Row 1: knit 3, pm, YO, K1, YO, pm, K1, pm, YO, K1, YO, pm, Knit 3/. Continue to follow chart until row 142.

Rows $142,144,145$ and 146 are all knit rows creating the bottom edge border. These rows are highlighted in orange on the chart. After completing these rows, bind off loosely.

Hints for Blocking

1. Do not darn in ends until blocking is complete 2. Wet shawl thoroughly with very mild warm water. 3. Place in a towel and roll up.
2. Gently twist the roll to remove excess water. 5. Block to size, pinning the top point of the edges. 6. Block at a minimum overnight.
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
